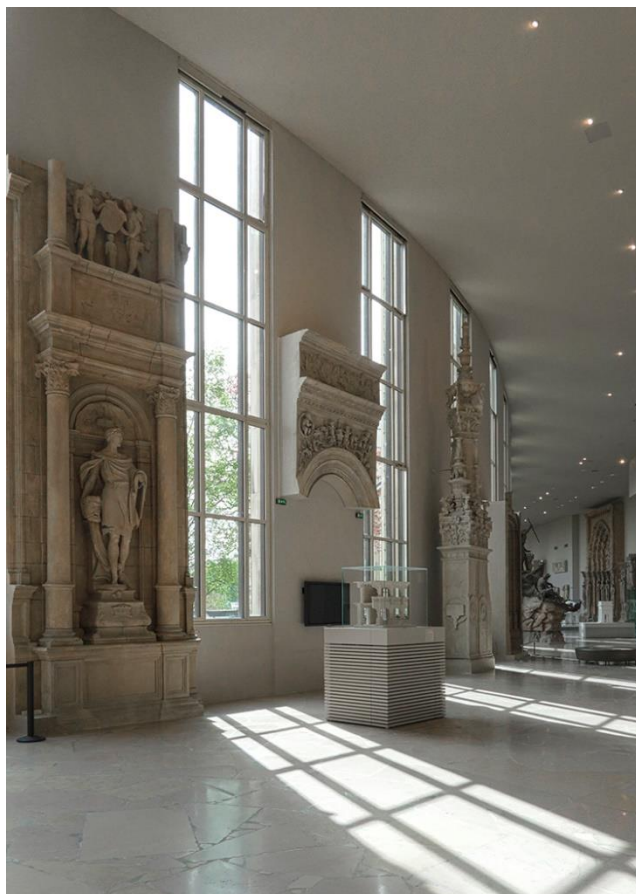

Payment by cheque or bank transfer only, terms of payment when validating your reservation.

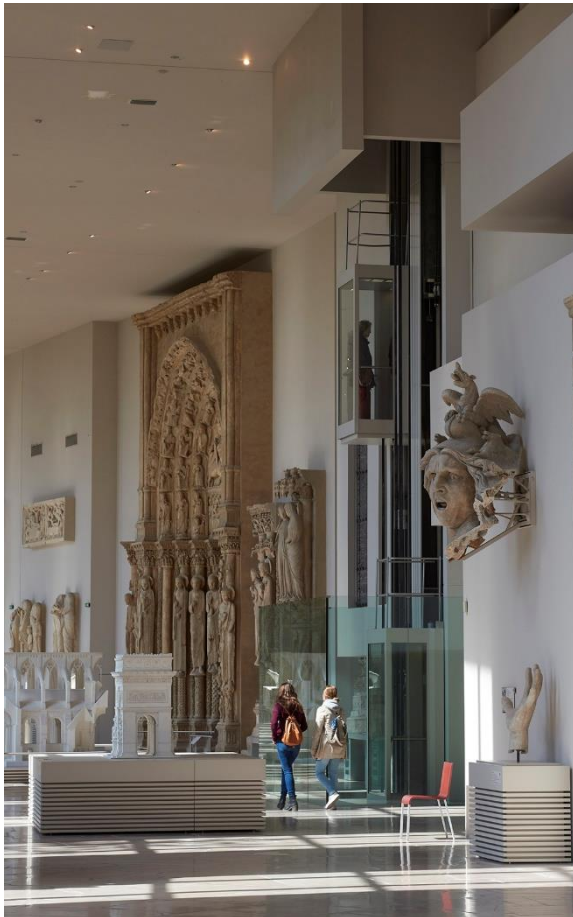
For security reasons all helmets and umbrellas should be secured in the locker provided, no suitcases of any size can be accommodated.

IMMERSION INTO FRENCH HERITAGE

This guided tour, ideal for your first exploration of our museum, discover the great periods of architecture from the Middle Ages to the present day, through a presentation of masterpieces, from the Romanesque portal of Moissac to the model of Le Corbusier's Cité Radieuse.



PARIS: ITS ARCHITECTURE AND ITS STORIES

Included in this guided tour, your chance to enjoy the magnificent works of the Cité retracing the architecture of Paris, from the gothic period through to modern day. In addition, you will also have the opportunity to appreciate the wonderful vista of the Eiffel Tower from the windows of the Cité!

REVIEW NOTRE-DAME DE PARIS, ITS SPIRE AND ITS SCULPTURES

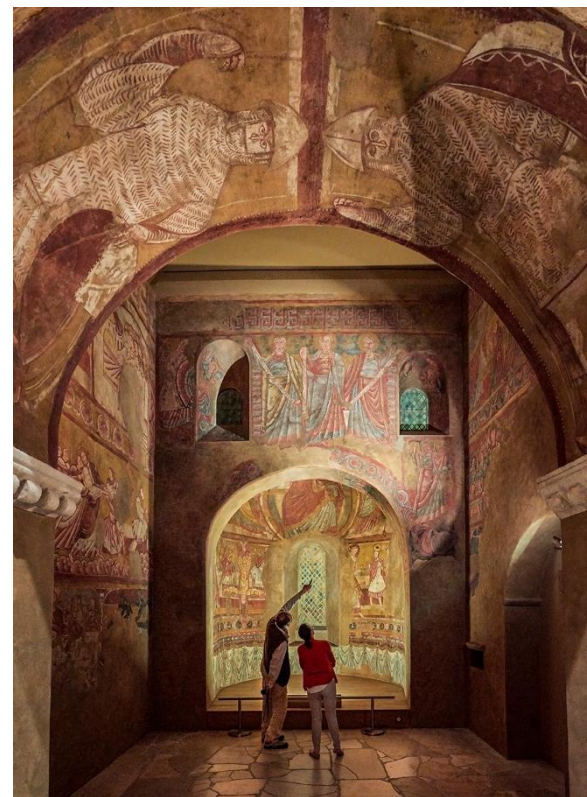
This visit retraces the long life of Notre-Dame de Paris, from the Gothic period to the present day. Usually, only viewable from a distance, we offer you the opportunity to get up close to the sixteen original and recently restored sculptures, from the missing spire of the cathedral, as well as the rooster at the top of the spire, bearing the marks of fire and its fall. A guided tour to explore the universal significance of this World Heritage monument.

THE SPECIALISED

SECRETS OF MEDIEVAL AND CLASSIC ARCHITECTURE

Follow the red thread of the architecture's evolution, from Romanesque to Gothic to the Renaissance. The fragments of life-size buildings as well as the models from the beginning of the 20th century allow you to understand the techniques of construction, to discover the sculpted decoration as well as the context of these historical periods.



COULOURS OF MEDIEVAL ART: EXCEPTIONAL WALL PAINTINGS

Enjoy an exceptional and unique collection: mysterious mural paintings, and, presents life-size reproductions of medieval frescoes in our labyrinthine gallery. Immersed in chapels, crypts and rooms of castles, you will discover real artistic jewels as well as their manufacturing techniques from the Middle Ages.

HAUSSMANN: THE BIRTH OF MODERN PARIS

Follow Haussmann's programme of urban renewal as he sought to complete his renovation of Paris. This guided tour explores the profound upheavals of the capital initiated by Napoleon the 3rd in the second half of the 19th century and which still mark Paris today.



ISSUES OF CONTEMPORARY ARCHITECTURE

Discover the museum's most contemporary projects. Thanks to the recently acquired models and the Parisian buildings visible from the windows, this visit takes you to the heart of today's architectural issues such as urban density, housing and ecology.

THE TOUR OF FRANCE OF ARCHITECTURE

Come and discover the architectural riches of our regions thanks to the life-size works and models on display. This guided tour offers you an immersive panorama of the heritage marvels of the French regions: from Romanesque Burgundy to the cathedrals of the North, from the castles on the banks of the Loire to the rockeries of the Grand Est.



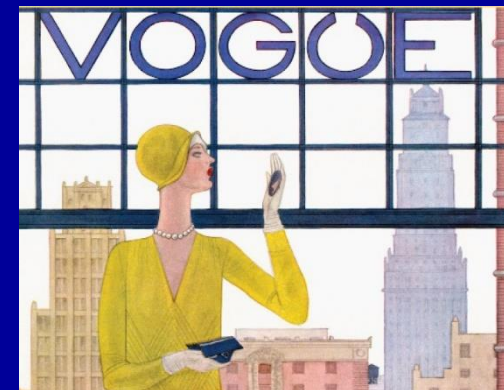
ART DECO WALK: THE PALAIS DE CHAILLOT

This guided tour invites you to discover the architecture of the Palais de Chaillot, an emblematic building of Art Deco and the design of the 1930s, which included the Cité. The view it offers allows you to explore the achievements of this sumptuous period, from the Eiffel Tower to the development of the Trocadéro gardens. *If you so choose, you can also admire the architecture on the exterior of the building as part of this tour.*



KNOWN AND UNKNOWN SYMBOLS FROM THE MIDDLE AGES

Medieval art is teeming with astonishing or unexpected details: what do these fantastic animals do on church Romanesque portals? Do abstract patterns have a hidden meaning? This visit focuses on deciphering the sculpted or painted medieval representations whose meaning has sometimes been lost...
