
## GUIDED TOURS FOR GROUPS

### Price information

Tour's price is fixed given two flat rates that depend on the number of attendees. Price includes:

- Entry tickets to the museum or to the temporary exhibition, valid for one day.
- 1h30 guided tour with a tour guide

Tour's flat rate can be changed up to 10 days before visiting day, day when the booking contract must be signed and received, along with payment.

Payment only through bank transfer, purchase order or check. Payment details will be given with your booking confirmation.


For safety reasons, helmets and umbrellas must be stored in our cloakrooms, while suitcases, skateboards and scooters are not permitted, regardless of their sizes.


The Cité de l'architecture presents the history of department stores, from their beginnings in 1852 to our present days. Spanning on nearly 1000m2 with a sensory journey, the exhibition takes you through the history of department stores and explores how these retail giants learned to adapt to 20th century's technological and societal revolutions, all the way through actual e-commerce challenges. Thanks to models, photographs, posters, furniture and other various objects (textile, dining ware, etc.), you will witness the evolution of these worldwide famous Parisian stores.

## SECRETS OF MEDIEVAL AND CLASSIC ARCHITECTURE

Follow the red thread of the architecture's evolution, from Romanesque, to Gothic, to the Renaissance. The fragments of life-size buildings as well as the models from the beginning of the 20th century allow you to understand techniques of construction, to discover the sculpted decoration as well as the context of these historical periods.





## COLOURS OF MEDIEVAL ART: EXCEPTIONAL WALL PAINTINGS

Enjoy an exceptional and unique collection! The mural paintings gallery, mysterious and tricky, presents life-size reproductions of medieval frescoes. Immersed in chapels, crypts and castles' rooms, you will discover real artistic gems as well as their manufacturing techniques from the Middle Ages.

#### HAUSSMANN:

#### THE UPRISING OF THE MODERN PARIS

Discover the greatest urban revolution known to Paris! The guided tour explores the disruptive project for the capital, initiated by Napoléon III in the second half of the 19th century, through the works of baron architect Haussmann, still marking the Parisian landscape nowadays.



### ISSUES OF CONTEMPORARY ARCHITECTURE

Discover the museum's most contemporary projects. Thanks to the recently acquired models and the Parisian buildings visible from the windows, this visit takes you to the heart of today's architectural issues such as urban density, housing and ecology.

#### THE TOUR OF FRANCE OF ARCHITECTURE

Come and discover the architectural gems of our regions thanks to the life-size works and models on display. This guided tour offers you an immersive overview of the heritage marvels of the French regions: from Romanesque Burgundy to the cathedrals of the North, from the castles on the banks of the Loire to the rockeries of the Grand Est.

### **WOMEN'S ROLE IN ARCHITECTURE**

With this visit, discover female figures who played a major role in the Middle Ages and the Renaissance, but their names are often unknown to us.

The exhibits in the museum are the starting point for rethinking the various roles played by women over the centuries. A new way to enjoy the history and architecture.

### ART DECO TOUR: LE PALAIS DE CHAILLOT

This guided tour invites you to discover the architecture of the Palais de Chaillot (which includes the Cité), an emblematic building of Art Deco and 1930s design. The view the Palais offers allows you to witness the achievements of this sumptuous period, from the Eiffel Tower to the development of the Trocadéro gardens. If you so choose, you can also admire the architecture on the exterior of the building as part of this tour.
