
GUIDED TOURS FOR GROUPS

Price informations

Tour's price is fixed given two flat rates that depend on the number of attendees. Price includes:

- Entry tickets to the museum or the temporary exhibition, valid for one day,
- 1h30 guided tour with a tour guide.

Tour's flat rate can be changed up to 10 days before visiting day, day when the booking contract must be signed and received, along with payment.

EXHIBITIONS

PARIS 1925: ART DECO AND ITS ARCHITECTS

From October 22, 2025 to March 29, 2026

Dive into the heart of the centenary celebrations of the International Exhibition of Modern Decorative and Industrial Arts in Paris, a landmark event that shaped the history of architecture and decorative arts.



MUTE - FABIENNE VERDIER + CHROMOSCOPEFrom October 22, 2025 to February 16, 2026

With Chromoscope and Mute – Fabienne Verdier, the Cité is launching a new exhibition series, bringing contemporary art into dialogue with our collections. Bridging the legacy of American Color Field painting and contemporary creation, these two exhibitions engage with medieval and classical architectures, where heritage meets abstraction.

Your tour guide will present you both exhibitions:

Mute - Fabienne Verdier: about forty large-format paintings made by the French artist between 1966 and 2024.

Chromoscope – A look at the Color Field: twenty-three monumental paintings from Color Field and post-painterly abstraction movements between 1955 and 1992.





QUARTIERS DE DEMAIN

From December 3, 2025 to March 29, 2026

Launched in June 2023 by the French President of the Republic, this international consultation aims to transform ten priority neighbourhoods under France's urban policy (QPV). Its goal is to imagine a new approach to building that improves residents' quality of life.

FIRST DISCOVERIES TOURS

IMMERSION INTO THE FRENCH HERITAGE

This guided tour, ideal for your first exploration of our museum, explores the great periods of architecture from the Mille Ages to the present day, through a presentation of masterpieces, from the Romanesque portal of Moissac to the model of Le Corbusier's Cité Radieuse.

Auguste Perret, Le Corbusier or Jean Nouvel and Renzo Piano... Discover the achievements of these great architects, from Marseille to Nouméa in the South Pacific, and travel through the past century following their innovative, revolutionary or romantic constructions.




SPECIALIZED TOURS

SECRETS OF MEDIEVAL AND CLASSIC ARCHITECTURE

Discover architecture and decoration's evolution in the Middle Ages, from the beginnings of the Romanesque period in the 11th century to the dawn of the Renaissance. Medieval architecture and sculpture will no longer have secrets for you!





COLOURS OF MEDIEVAL ART: EXCEPTIONAL WALL PAINTINGS

Enjoy an exceptional and unique collection! The mural paintings gallery, mysterious and tricky, presents life-size reproductions of medieval frescoes. Immersed in chapels, crypts and castles' rooms, you will discover real artistic gems as well as their manufacturing techniques from the Middle Ages.

HAUSSMANN: THE UPRISING OF THE MODERN PARIS

Discover the greatest urban revolution known to Paris! The guided tour explores the disruptive project for the French capital, initiated by Napoleon III in the second half of the 19th century, through the works of baron architect Haussmann, still marking the Parisian landscape nowadays.



ISSUES OF CONTEMPORARY ARCHITECTURE

Discover the museum's most contemporary projects. Thanks to the recently acquired models and the Parisian buildings visible from the windows, this visit takes you to the heart of today's architectural issues such as urban density, housing and ecology.

UNPRECEDENTED TOURS

THE TOUR OF FRANCE OF ARCHITECTURE

Come and discover the architectural gems of our regions thanks to the life-size works and models on display. This guided tour offers you an immersive overview of the heritage marvels of the French regions: from Romanesque Burgundy to the cathedrals of the North, from the castles on the banks of the Loire to the rockeries of the Grand Est.



ART DECO TOUR: THE PALAIS DE CHAILLOT

This guided tour invites you to discover the architecture of the Palais de Chaillot (which includes the Cité), an emblematic building of Art Deco and 1930s design. The view the Palais offers allows you to witness the achievements of the sumptuous period, from the Eiffel Tower to the development of the Trocadéro gardens.

If you so choose, you can also admire the architecture on the exterior of the building as a part of this tour, weather permitting.



WOMEN'S ROLE IN ARCHITECTURE

With this visit, discover female figures who played a major role in the Middle Ages and the Renaissance, but their names are often unknown to us.

The exhibits in the museum are the starting point for rethinking the various roles played by women over centuries. A new way to enjoy the history and architecture.



KNOWN AND UNKNOWN SYMBOLS FROM THE MIDDLE AGES

Medieval art is teeming with astonishing or unexpected details: what do these fantastic animals do on Romanesque church portals? Do abstract patterns have a hidden meaning? This visit focuses on deciphering the sculpted or painted medieval representations whose meaning has sometimes been lost...
