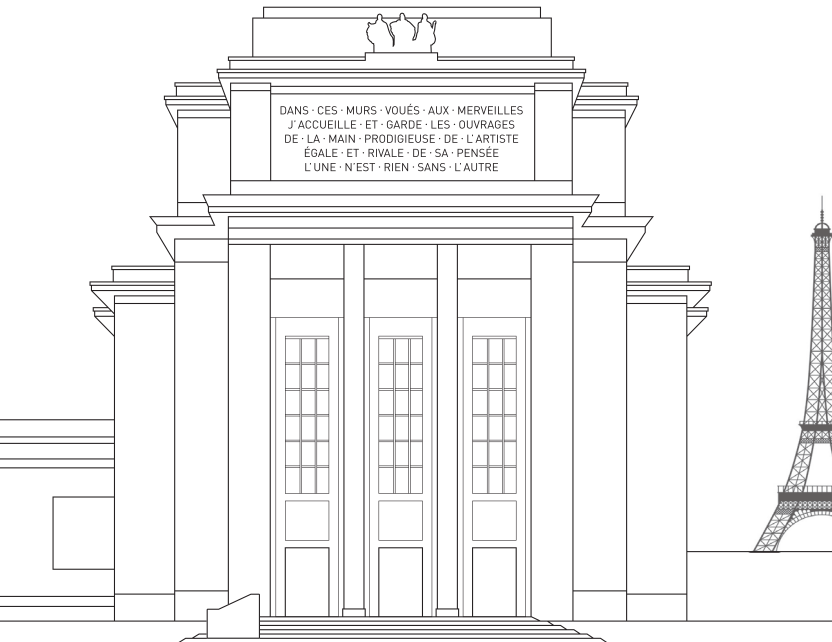

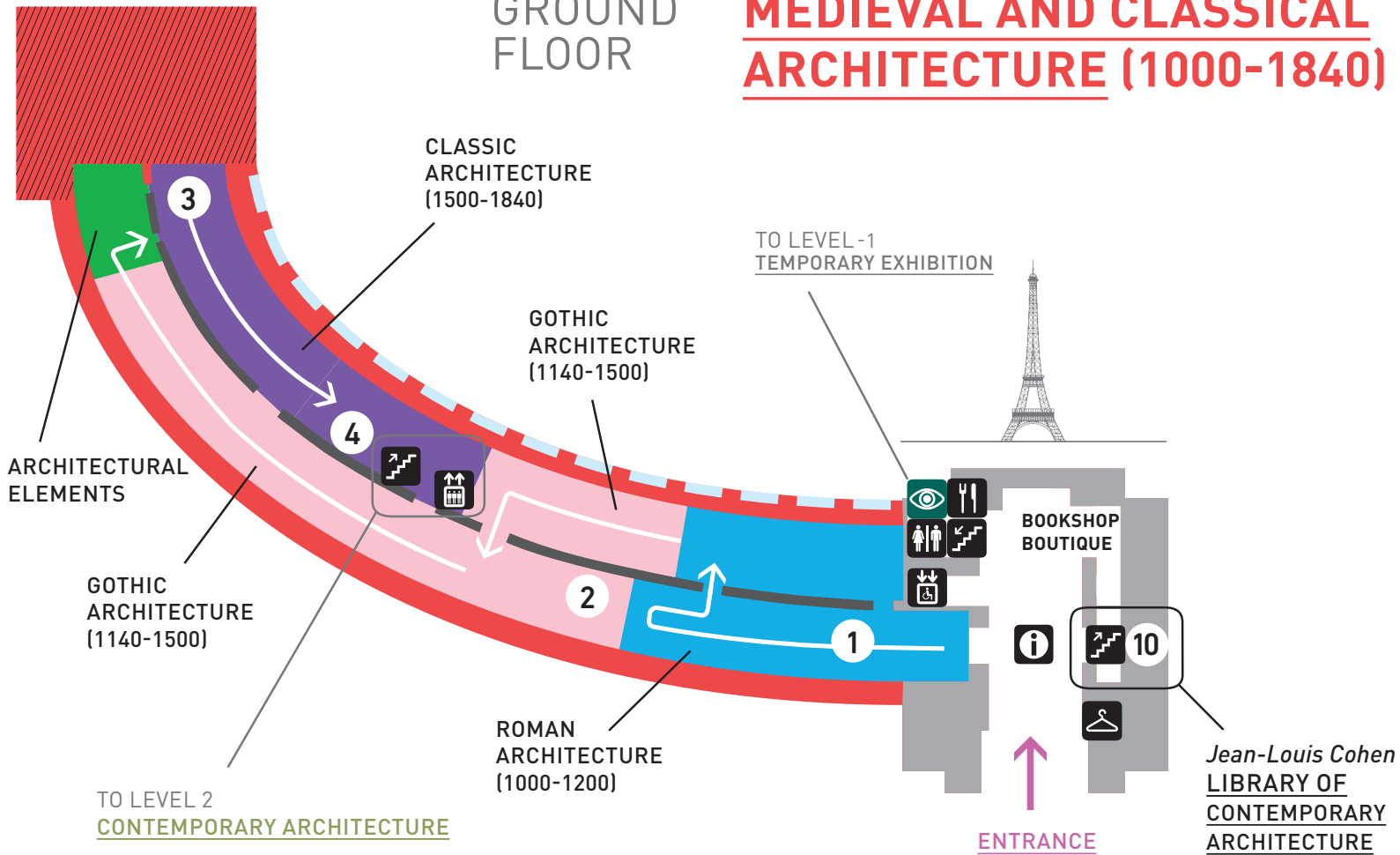

VISIT MAP

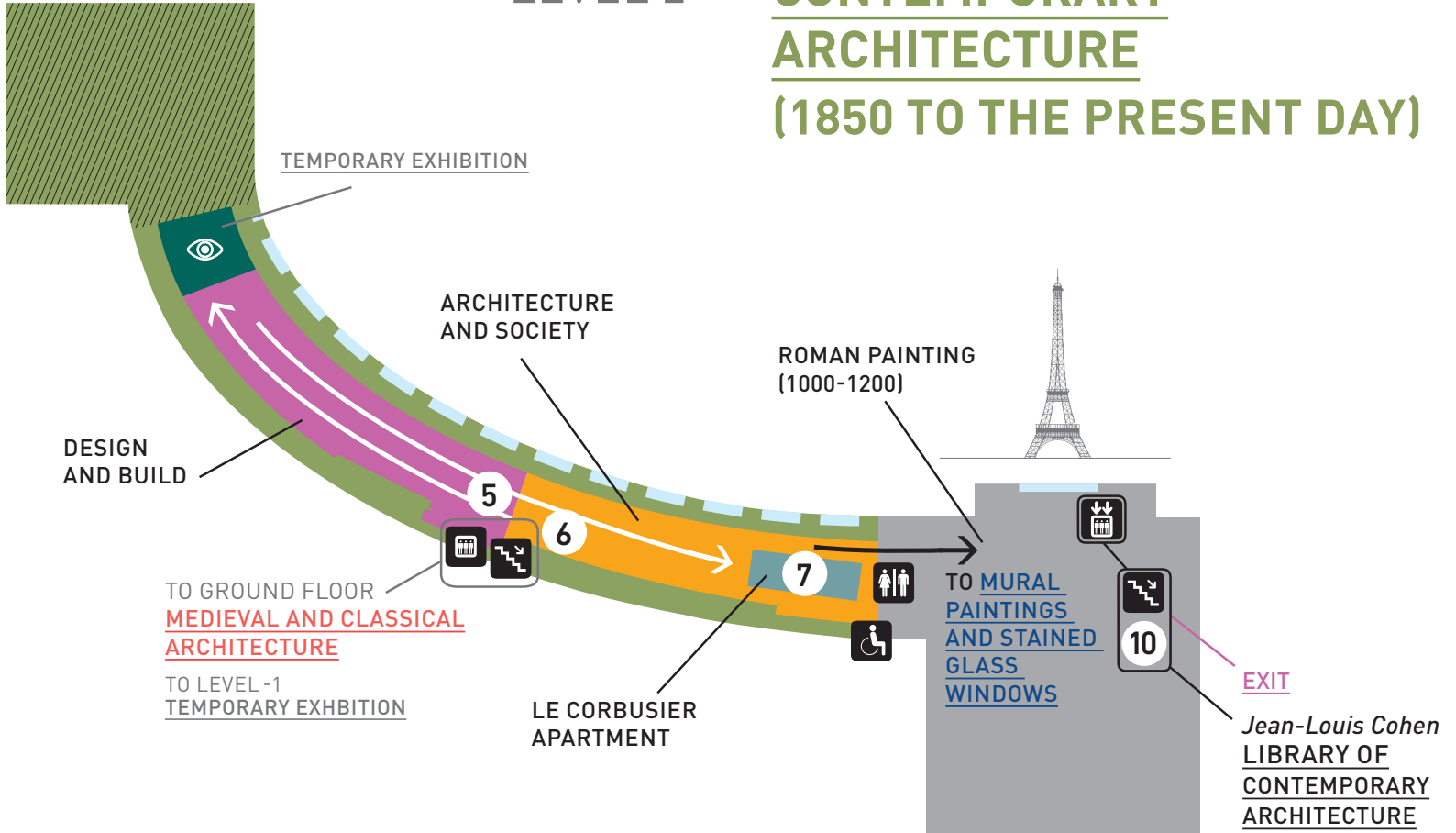

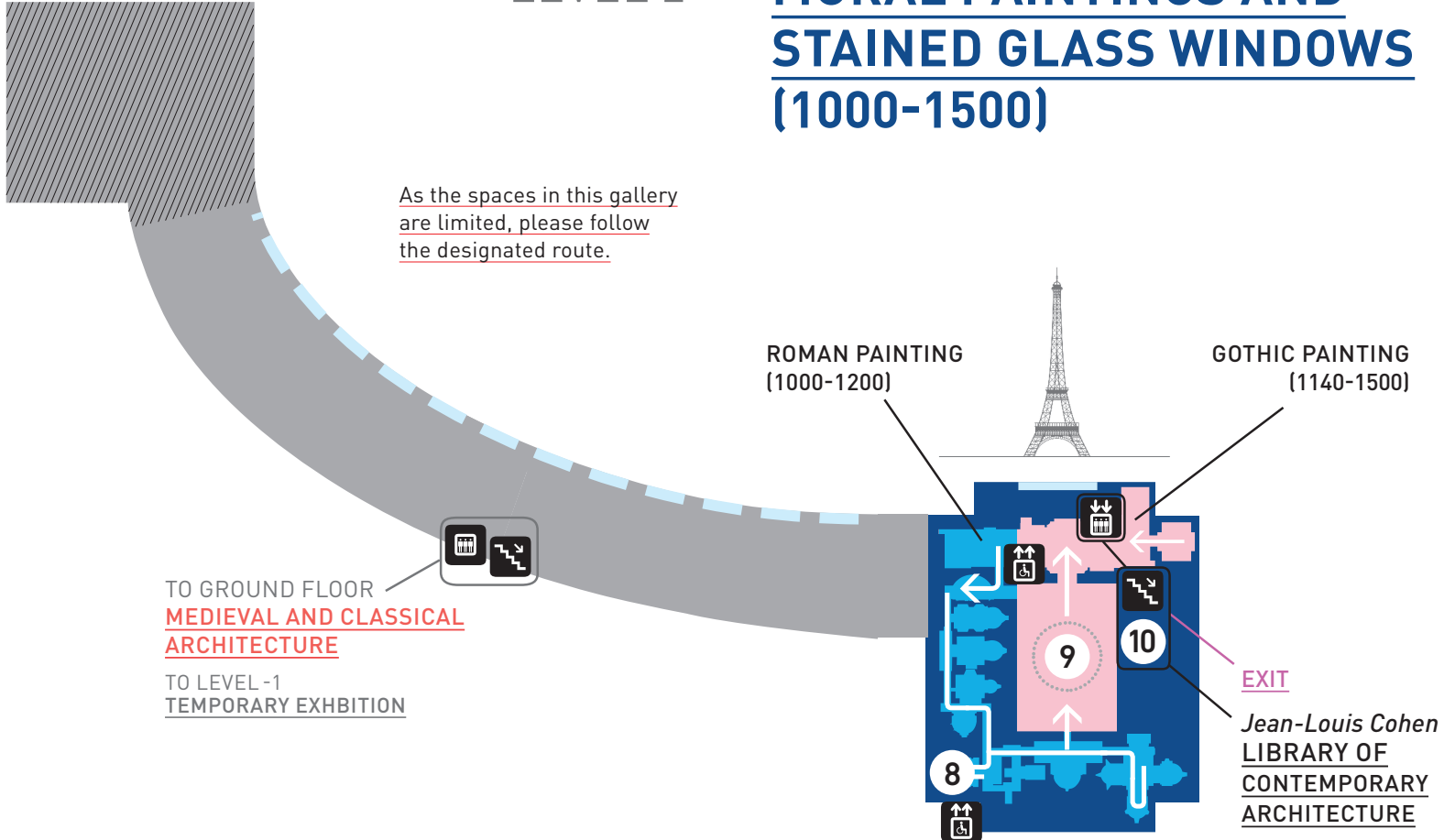

MEDIEVAL AND CLASSICAL ARCHITECTURE (1000-1840)

Started in 1879 by Eugène Viollet-le-Duc, the impressive collection of plaster casts takes visitors on a journey through nine centuries of French architectural history. The chronological tour invites visitors to discover iconic civil and religious monuments from the roman period to the industrial Revolution.

CONTEMPORARY (1850 TO THE PRESENT DAY)

This gallery, which opened in 2007, offers an overview of architecture from 1850 to the present day. Models, life-size elements, archive films and printed material are displayed thematically. From innovations that revolutionised the art of building to architect's responses to contemporary challenges, visitors can gain an understanding of the transformations and characteristics of the period.

MURAL PAINTINGS AND STAINED GLASS WINDOWS (1000-1500)

Opened in 1937, this gallery displays a collection of reproductions from roman and gothic murals. It showcases a major aspect of medieval architecture: painted wall decorations.

Unique in Europe, this immersive space invites visitors to discover the evolution and characteristics of murals.

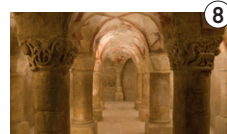

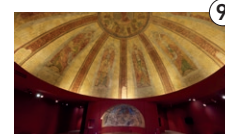
